27.5.18 Memo to OI/c from Salisbury E/E notifying B's transfer to Messrs Andersons Henlow on completion of contract (Ack. 12.8.18)

7.9.18 Letter to OI/c from B. on behalf of A.M.W's at Henlow enquiring if any exemption allowed on income tax for time lost travelling to and from Aust. (Ack. 11.9.18 No exemption on account of loss of time. Advised to see local Surveyor of Taxes.)

2.11.18 Called: Discharged by Messrs. Anderson at an hour's notice as work finished. Manager of E/E lived 10 miles away so came to London. Manager Aldwych E/E communicated with B. told to report and lodge claim for sub.allow. at Aldwych E/E.

8.11.18 Began work with Messrs John Brown & Co. Attercliffe Sheffield as bricklayer. Returned postcard with particulars.

14.3.19 Letter to OI/c from B. stating has not received claim for sub.allow. (3 days in November) lodged at Aldwych E/E. Enquires re repatriation. (Ack. 21.3.19 Will probably be repatriated in 6 or 8 week's time)

20.3.19 Letter from OI/c to Manager Aldwych E/E enquiring re B's sub.allow. claim.

15.4.19 Letter to OI/c from B. Wishes to marry and travel with bride to Aust. (Ack. 16.4.19 Form 415 enclosed to be returned completed with Marriage Cert: as soon as possible. Matter urgent as free passages may be withdrawn by M. of L.)

Undated Letter to OI/c from B. enclosing marriage cert. and form 415. Requests to travel on same boat with wife (Ack. 7.5.19 Will travel together; steamer probably sailing at the end of June or some time in July. Not to leave work until receipt of final embarkation instructions.)

30.5.19 Letter from OI/c to B. With cheque enclosed for £1.0.0 from M. of L. in settlement of sub.allow due.

7.6.19 Letter to OI/c from B. Has received notice to travel about end of month "Without dependents" as all arrangements have been made for wife to travel with him with explanation. (Ack. 13.6.19 The form "Without dependents" was forwarded in error. Listed to sail with wife on Bahia Castillo.)

19.6.19 Letter to OI/c from B. States wife is willing to sail on date mentioned.

4.7.19 Memo from OI/c to B. To report at Plymouth 14.7.19 for embarkation on s.s. Bahia Castillo. *Rh*
